The Auburn Research Park, which opened in September 2008, is being developed as a mixed-use research and business campus. Establishment of the park was the result of a partnership between the State of Alabama, Auburn University, and the City of Auburn. The mission of the Auburn Research Park, as an evolving entity, is to support and enhance the Auburn University research enterprise and economic development through the creation of knowledge-based jobs.

The vision for the park is to establish an entrepreneurial environment through business development and research that fosters creativity and innovation, embraces collaboration and partnerships, and promotes a networking structure that leads to economic growth and diversification along with enhanced economic vitality for the local, state and regional communities.

The Auburn Research Park will play a significant role in leveraging Auburn University's intellectual property assets to technology-based economic development by facilitating technology transfer, developing industry partnerships, forming and nurturing new business ventures, and attracting knowledge-based companies to the park.
